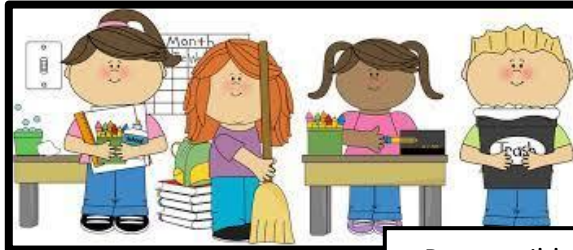


How do we look after each other and the world? Year 1 – Term 5
