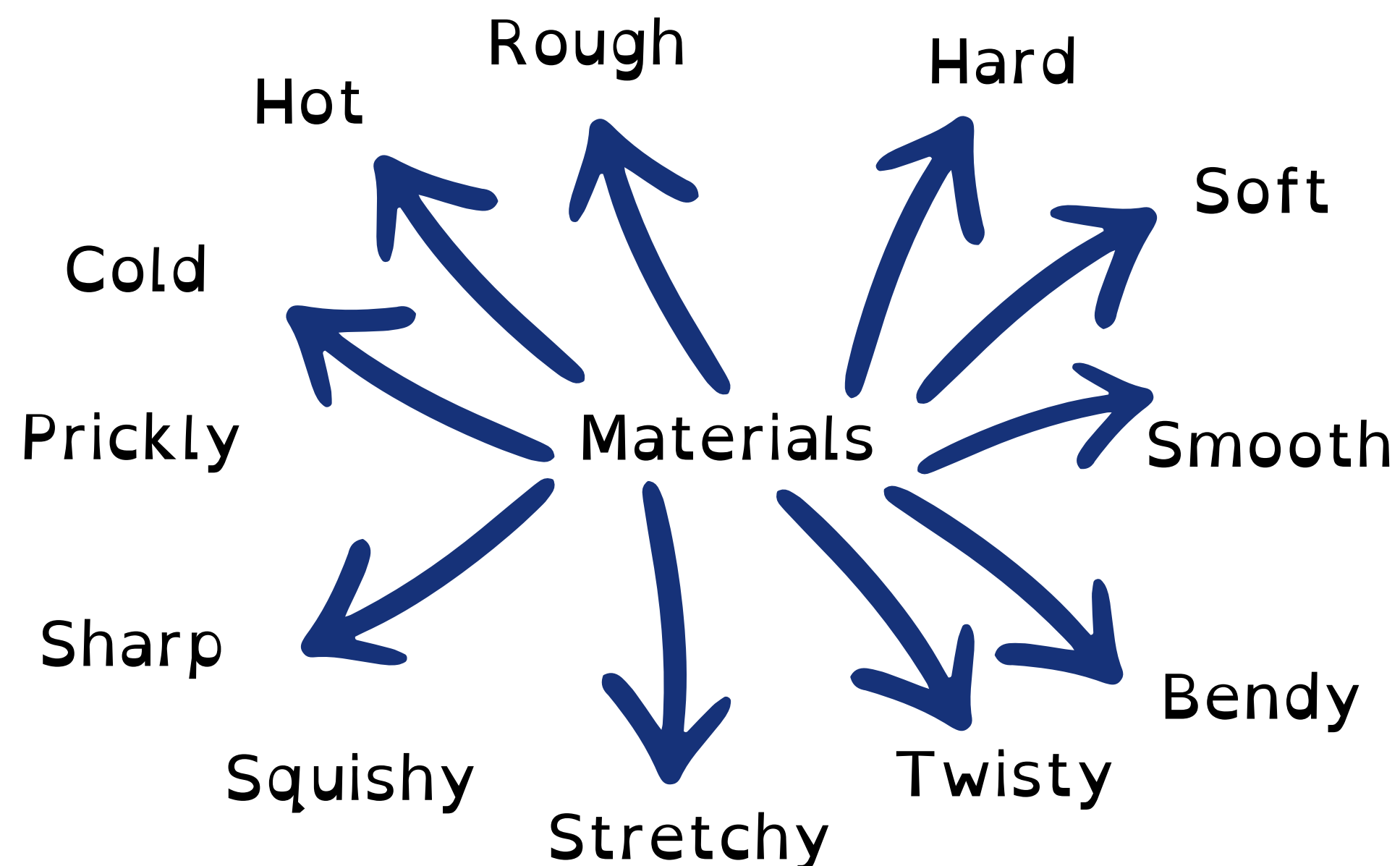

What are the properties of different materials?

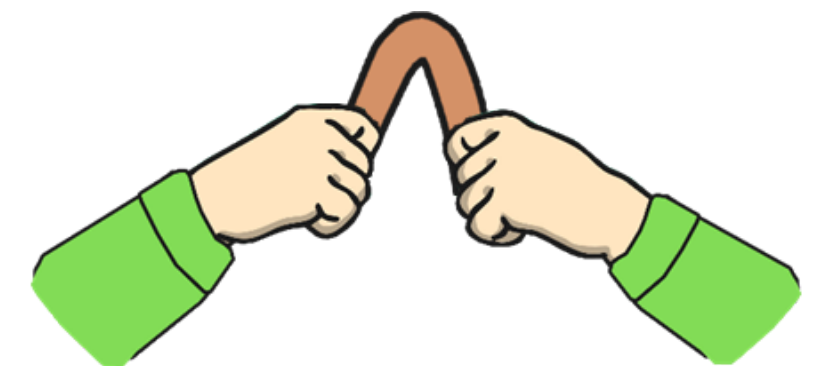

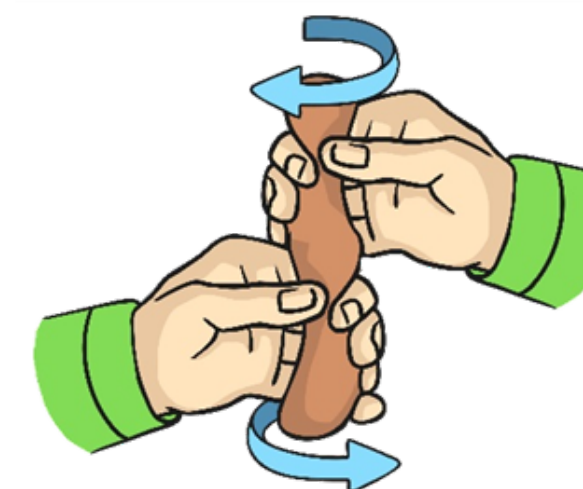

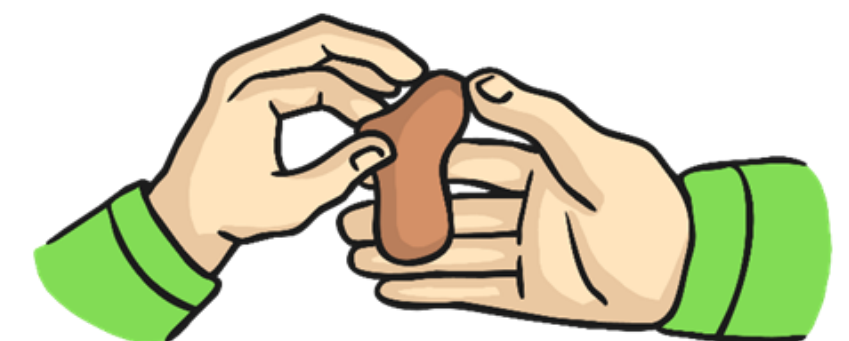
